2022 APPLICATION FOR GLASS SCHOLARSHIP

The Valley of Alexandria, Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite of Freemasonry Glass Fund Scholarships are awarded based on academic achievement and extra-curricular activities to qualifying high school seniors. The number of scholarships awarded will be determined based upon available funds. Previous awardees are invited to renew their application for up to 3 consecutive years (sophomore, junior, and senior year.) These scholarships are open to anyone attending a two- or four-year college or university or seeking a post-secondary vocational training or certification.

ALL Applicants Must*

- (a) be a US Citizen
- (b) be a member of Job's Daughters, Rainbow, or DeMolay; or related to a member of the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite, Valley of Alexandria, VA in good standing (living or deceased). Consideration *may* be given for someone connected to a Freemason in general but not the Alexandria Valley.
- (c) Be attending (or planning to attend) a two- or four-year college or university or seeking a post-secondary vocational training or certification.

**No preference is given to any person based on race, gender, or religion.*

New Application Directions (First Time)

1. Complete ALL Items on the Application
2. Provide high school or most current college transcript
3. Provide a 250-to-500-word essay
4. Recommended but not required, letters of recommendation (limit of 3)

Renewal Application Directions

1. Complete ONLY the starred items (*), sign, and date.
2. Provide an essay *update* (see Essay Prompt in the Application on Page 4)

**Completed signed application packages MUST be returned no later than March 31, 2022.
 ONLY complete applications with all required documentation will be considered.**

Scholarship awards will be announced on or before April 30th.

If selected, a current electronic headshot photo is needed for publication of scholarship award(s).
